Caecilius <u>used to look at</u> the son.

Perfect tense = simple past Caecilius filium <u>spectavit</u>. Caecilius looked at the son.

Pluperfect = past from a past perspective Caecilius, postquam filium <u>spectaverat</u>, villam intravit. Caecilius, after he <u>had looked at</u> the son, entered the house.
